Arrange the Sun, Earth, and Moon in correct positions—Moon between Sun and Earth for a solar eclipse, and Earth between Sun and Moon for a lunar eclipse. Show shadows using shading or black paper and label all the parts neatly. Add a brief explanation (1-2 lines each) for both eclipses.
